

Ernest Davies Award

Competition details and time scale

Eligibility

Applicants may submit an entry relating to any aspect of the parking sector. An individual, team or company (including previous winners) can submit a technical or innovative piece of content which might be an achievement and can be humorous or serious.

Type of entry

The entry could be a; report – blog – article – poem – case study – statistical analysis – video recording or audio recording

Rules

The written or recorded entry must **not**:

- Promote a product or service
- Simply be a progress/standard report written in the course of the author's work
- Be by one of the judges, a professional journalist, a PR professional on behalf of themselves or others, or a member of the BPA staff team
- Be produced outside the qualifying period

Additionally, entries:

- Must be substantially the author's own work - joint authorship is allowed
- May be commissioned articles for which an honorarium or similar payment is paid by the BPA



- Competition opens and applications invited
- Applications sent to Judging panel
- Scores submitted and winners decided
- Shortlisted nominations announced in November edition Parking News
- •Award presented
- Winning article published in Parking News

Judges

The judges' decision is final. Where the judges are unable to agree on a winner, their comments and resulting recommendations will be put to the Chair (or another member) of the Public Affairs and Communications Board who will make the final decision.

The judges will include the editor of Parking News, the chair or vice Chair of the Public Affairs and Communications Board, the vice president, a council member and a senior BPA staff member.
